This almost evergreen plant grows during the cool parts of the year and is enjoyed by moles, rabbits, deer, and turkey.



Rough Blazingstar

Liatris aspera

Delicious underground storage systems similar to bulbs, but they are not layered like onions, they are solid, and called a corm. Birds eat their seeds and rodent will eat their corms.

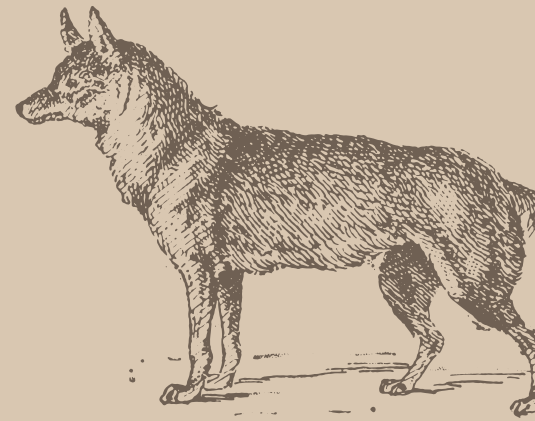
SLOW COOKED FILLET OF FOX SQUIRREL



Fox squirrel

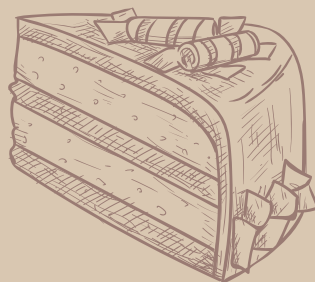
Sciurus niger
